

Biography Sylvia Brécko

Born and based in Germany Austrian artist Sylvia Brécko is known as a former TV-presenter and host in German TV (WDR & ARD).

Before she started her TV-career Sylvia was educated in dancing, speaking, acting and singing in Cologne, Hamburg, San Francisco and New York – one of her singing teachers being Béla Mavrak, tenor in the ensemble of Andre Rieu.

In addition Sylvia holds a degree in Theatre-, Film- and TV-science, German literature and art history.

From 2002 on Sylvia created - beside her work as a bilingual MC - different cabaret and comedy shows:

- 2003: Chanson evening “Mythos” about famous women such as Piaf, Dietrich and Monroe.
- 2007: first musical comedy „Liebling, findest Du mich zu dick?“
- 2010: musical comedy “Liebling, wir müssen reden!”
- 2013: musical comedy „Liebling, wie war ich?“/
- 2015: First Christmas comedy show
- 2015-2019: Attending with English versions of her shows at the ADL Fringe etc..
- 2020: Musical comedy „Das letzte Kind trägt Fell“
- 2021: Her book of the same name is being published.
- 2023: Premiere with the English version of „Das letzte Kind trägt Fell“ at the ADL Fringe: „Fur Baby“.
- 2023: Touring with her show in Belgium, Austria & Spain, as well first reading in New York City
- 2024: Renewed participation with ‚Fur Baby‘ at the Adelaide Fringe Festival.
